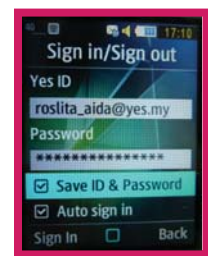
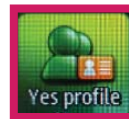
1 How to power up your Buzz?

- Open up your Buzz box
- Get hold of the battery
- Slot the battery to the back of the Buzz device and slide the back cover until you hear a 'click' sound
- Press on the Switch On button



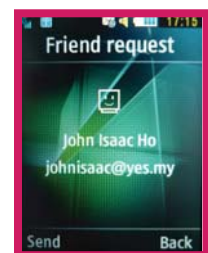
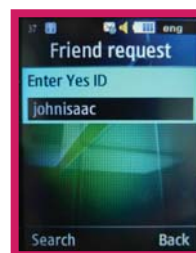
2 Sign in and sign out

- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **Yes profile**
- Select **Option No. 5 - Sign in/ Sign out**
- Enter your **Yes ID** and **Password**
- Check on the **Save ID & Password**
- Check on the **Auto sign in**
(auto sign in allows your Buzz to sign in automatically when it detects the network after signing out)



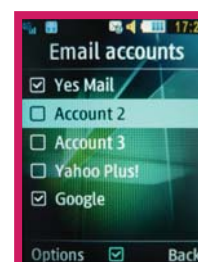
3 Friend request

- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **Yes profile**
- Select **Option No. 4 - Friend Request** (please ensure you are signed into the Yes network)
- Type in your Yes friend's ID and click **Search**
- A message will be sent to your friend to Accept the invite once you click on **Send**



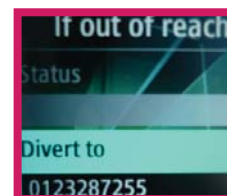
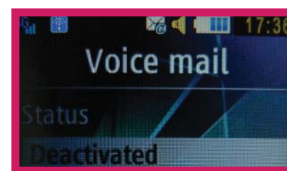
4 Setting up your Yes mail

- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **Messages**
- Select **Option No. 11 - Settings**
(please ensure the time and date of your Buzz is current before you do this)
- Select **Option No. 2 - Email**
- Select **Option No. 4 - Email accounts**
- Check the box where Yes Mail is indicated
- Click **OK** when the confirmation screen appears
(Click on other Account 2 and so on to set up your Google or Yahoo mail. Buzz can support up to 5 email accounts at any one time).



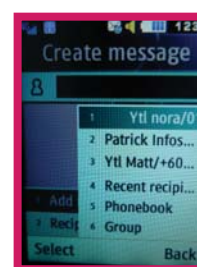
5 Setting up Call Forward - out of reach

- Before you activate the **Call Forward** feature, you need to **deactivate your Voicemail**
- So, go to the **Settings** menu
- Look for **Option No. 5 - Call Settings**
- Select **Option No. 1 - Supplementary Services**
- Select **Option No. 5 - Voicemail**
- Click on **Options** and select **Option No.2 - Deactivate**
- Save the change
- Now, on the same **Supplementary Services** menu, select **Option No. 1 - Call forwarding**
- Select **Option No. 4 - If out of reach**
- Enter the preferred Malaysian or International mobile number that you wish your voice calls to be forwarded to when you are unable to be reached through your Buzz (example: 0123287255) (If you forward your call to an International Number, please be wary of the IDD call charge as the forwarding leg will be connected all the way to that destination country. Check out our IDD rates at www.yes.my. Your caller will only be charged domestic rate)
- Click on **Options** and select **Option No. 1 - Activate**



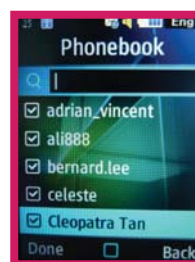
6 Creating an SMS

- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **Messages**
- Select **Option No. 1 - Message**
- Select your recipient from your **Phonebook** or **Recent recipient** or enter the desired mobile number



7 Starting a Chat

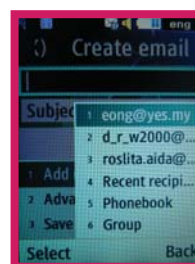
- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **Messages**
- Select **Option No.1-Create message**
- Select **Option No. 2 - Chat**
- Buzz will display all the Yes friends you have in your Contacts list and you need to select the Yes friends that you wish to chat with, use the Yes button to confirm your selection
- Click on **Done** and start chatting



(Maximum group chat is up to 6 Yes ID contacts including the chat initiator)

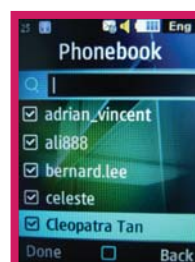
8 Creating an email

- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **Messages**
- Select **Option No.1-Create message**
- Select **Option No. 3 - Email**
- Select your recipient from your **Phonebook** or **Recent recipient** or enter the desired email address or send to a **Group** (you will need to create a group before you can send email to a group)
- Create a **Subject** and type the desired content of your email
- Press the confirmation key (with big Yes button) to send the email



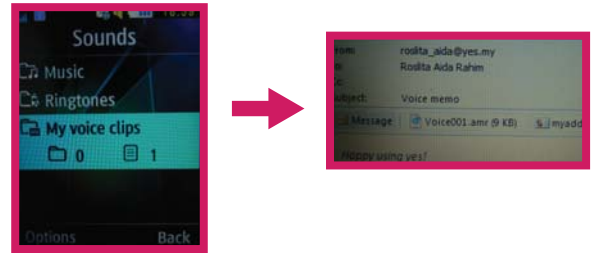
9 Transfer a file (your favourite photo or music)

- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **Messages**
- Select **Option No. 4 - File Transfer**
- Buzz will display all the Yes friends you have in your Contacts list and you need to select the Yes friends that you wish to share the file with. Use the Yes button to confirm your selection
- Your Yes friend will need to Accept the file transfer in order for the transfer to be successful



10 Sending a Voice Memo

- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **Applications**
- Select **Option No. 8 - Voice recorder** to record your voice
- Once recorded, you can send the recorded voice immediately at this menu or retrieve the recorded voice from the **My Files - Sounds - My voice clips**
- Click on **Options** and send via email to recipient from your **Phonebook** or **Recent recipient** or enter the desired email address or send to a **Group** (you will need to create a group before you can send email to a group)
- When the **Security Alert** is prompted, click on **Accept**
- Your recipient will receive an email (on real-time) with your recorded voice



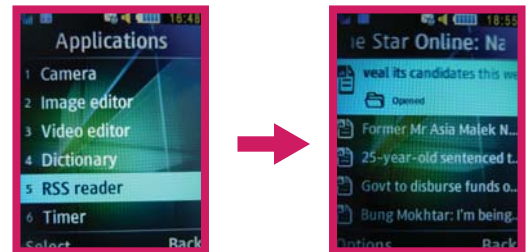
11 Accessing YouTube

- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **YouTube**
- Start looking for your favourite video clips, movies or aspiring talks on YouTube and enjoy the streaming without buffering



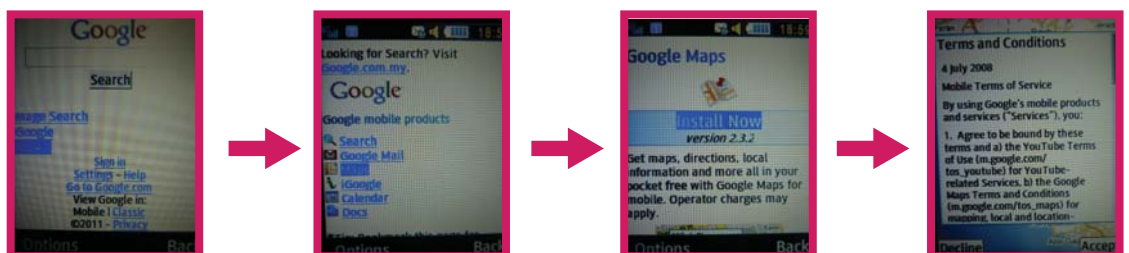
12 Setting RSS feed

- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **Applications** select **RSS reader**
- **Add New** to access to your preferred website or go to an existing site that you have updated earlier on to get the latest headlines and news updates



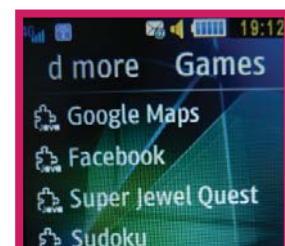
13 Download Google Maps

- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **Browser**
- Select **Option No. 3 - Bookmarks** and look for **Google**
- Once the page opens, click on **more...** and later select **Maps**
- Select **Install Now**, **Save** the file and click on **Accept**
- Enjoy your Google maps and use it as your alternative to a GPS device to get from one place to another within Malaysia (in future, Google maps is accessible under **Menu - Games & More**)



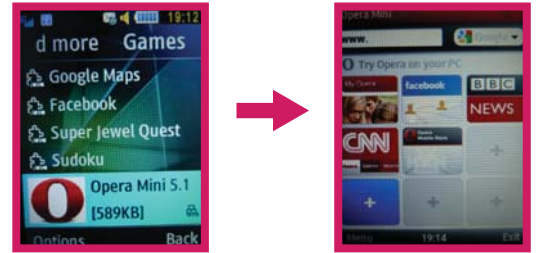
14 Download games and songs

- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **Browser**
- Select **Option No. 3 - Bookmarks** and look for **Google**
- Once the page opens, type **games** in the search field
- And select any of your favourite free Java games and enjoy them as you go
- All successfully downloaded games on your Buzz are available under **Games & More**



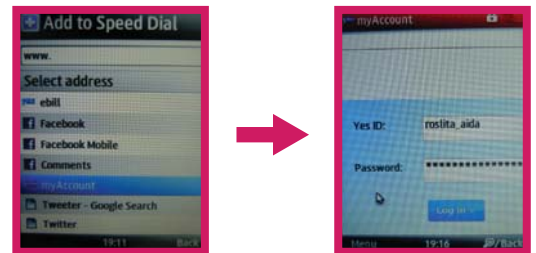
15 Using Opera Mini browser to access websites

- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **Games & More**
- Select **Opera Mini Browser 5.1**
- Once the page opens, you can select to any of defaulted installed webpages or click to any of the [+] and add a new page
- Enjoy surfing...



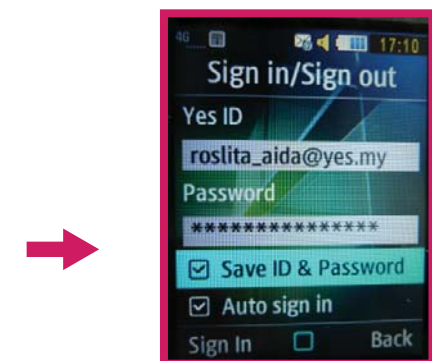
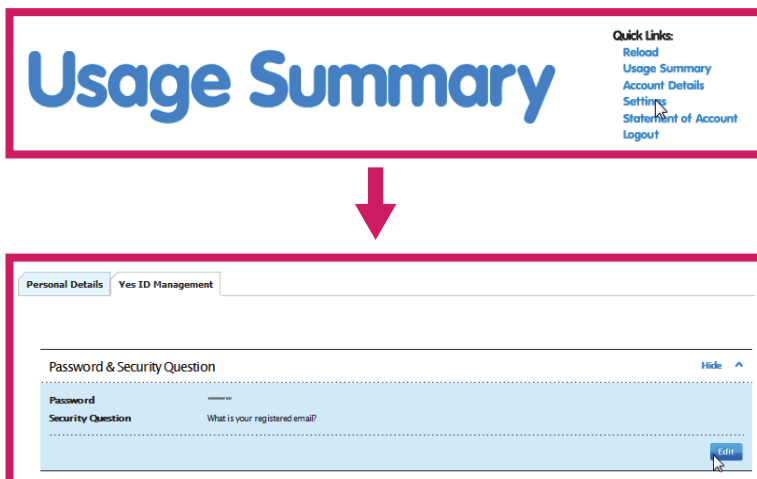
16 Accessing My Account to check Usage Summary and Account Details

- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **Games & More**
- Select **Opera Mini Browser 5.1**
- Once the page opens, enter our Yes Portal address at **www.yes.my**
- Once Yes Portal opens, select **My Account** under the menu
- At the login screen, **enter your Yes ID and password** to access your Yes account (use the Zoom in function to have clearer view of the Yes Portal)



17 Changing Yes ID Password

- Click on **Menu**
- Look for **Games & More**
- Select **Opera Mini Browser 5.1**
- Once the page opens, enter our Yes Portal address at **www.yes.my**
- Once Yes Portal opens, select **My Account** under the menu
- At the login screen, **enter your Yes ID and password** to access your Yes account
- Once you are in **My Account**, look for the word **Settings**
- Under the **Yes ID Management** function, select **Edit** and enter the new preferred password (just follow the steps on the screen)
- Once the password is changed, you will need to re-login to your Buzz under the **Sign In/ Sign Out** function once again using the new password that you have just reset



18 Using Buzz as a modem

- Go to **Menu**
- Go to **Settings**
- Scroll to find **Phone Settings**
- Scroll to **PC connections**
- Choose **Ask on Connection** & save the change
- Connect the phone to a computer and select WiMAX modem on the phone selection screen
- Wait for plug and play process to finish. Once done, you are connected to YES 4G network.
